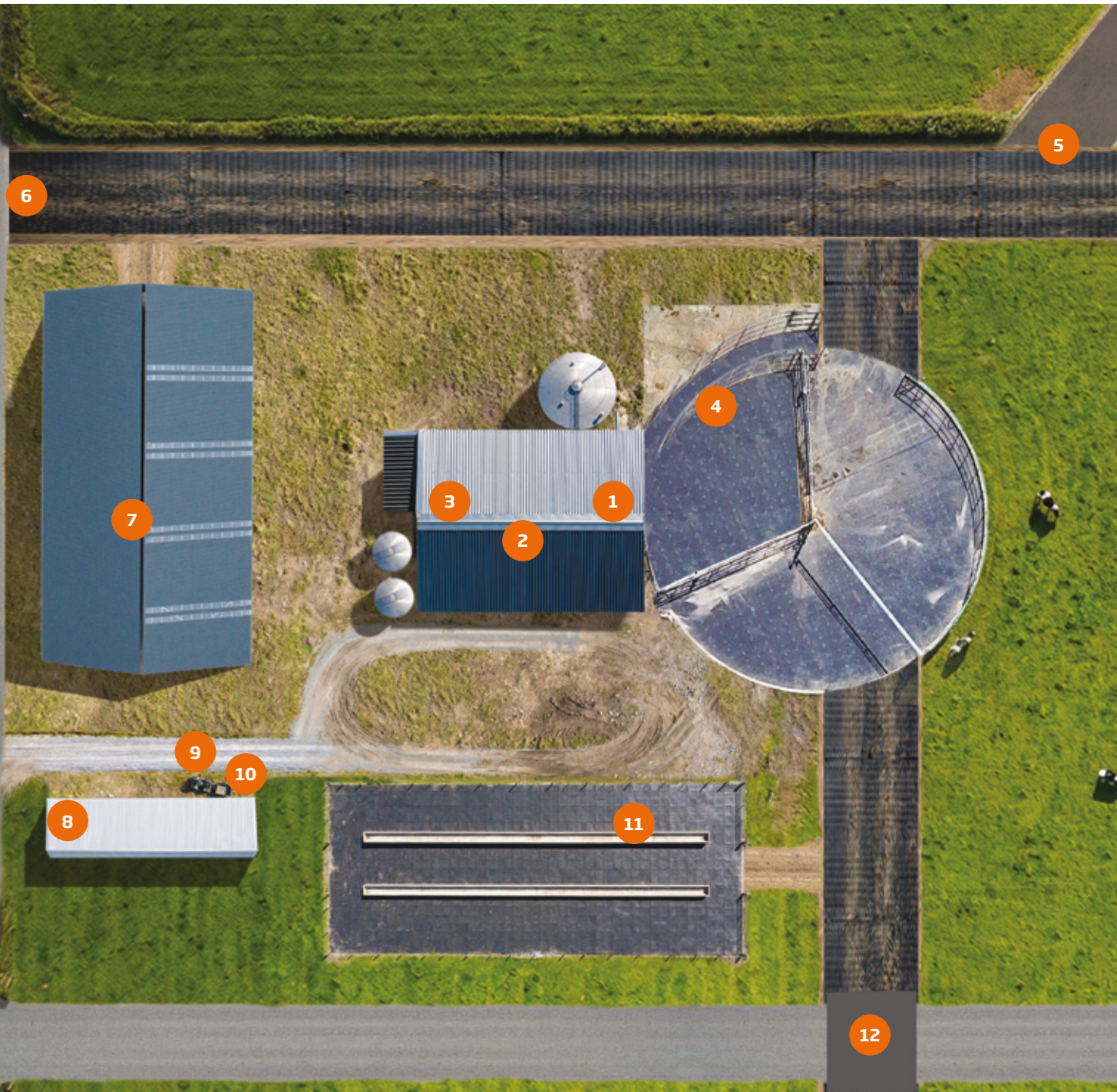

COW YARDS

Bare concrete yards are hard on hooves. Standing cows twice a day, 300 days a year, adds up to serious wear. **Lame cows produce less**, cost more in vet bills, and take longer to move. Rubber matting fixes that at the source.

A lame cow costs an estimated \$200-\$600 minimum per incident in lost production and treatment costs. In a 500-cow herd, that adds up fast. **The mat investment** looks very different when you run that number.

The **yard also becomes your stand-off pad**. It protects pasture through winter without the nitrogen leaching that comes with muddy sacrifice paddocks.

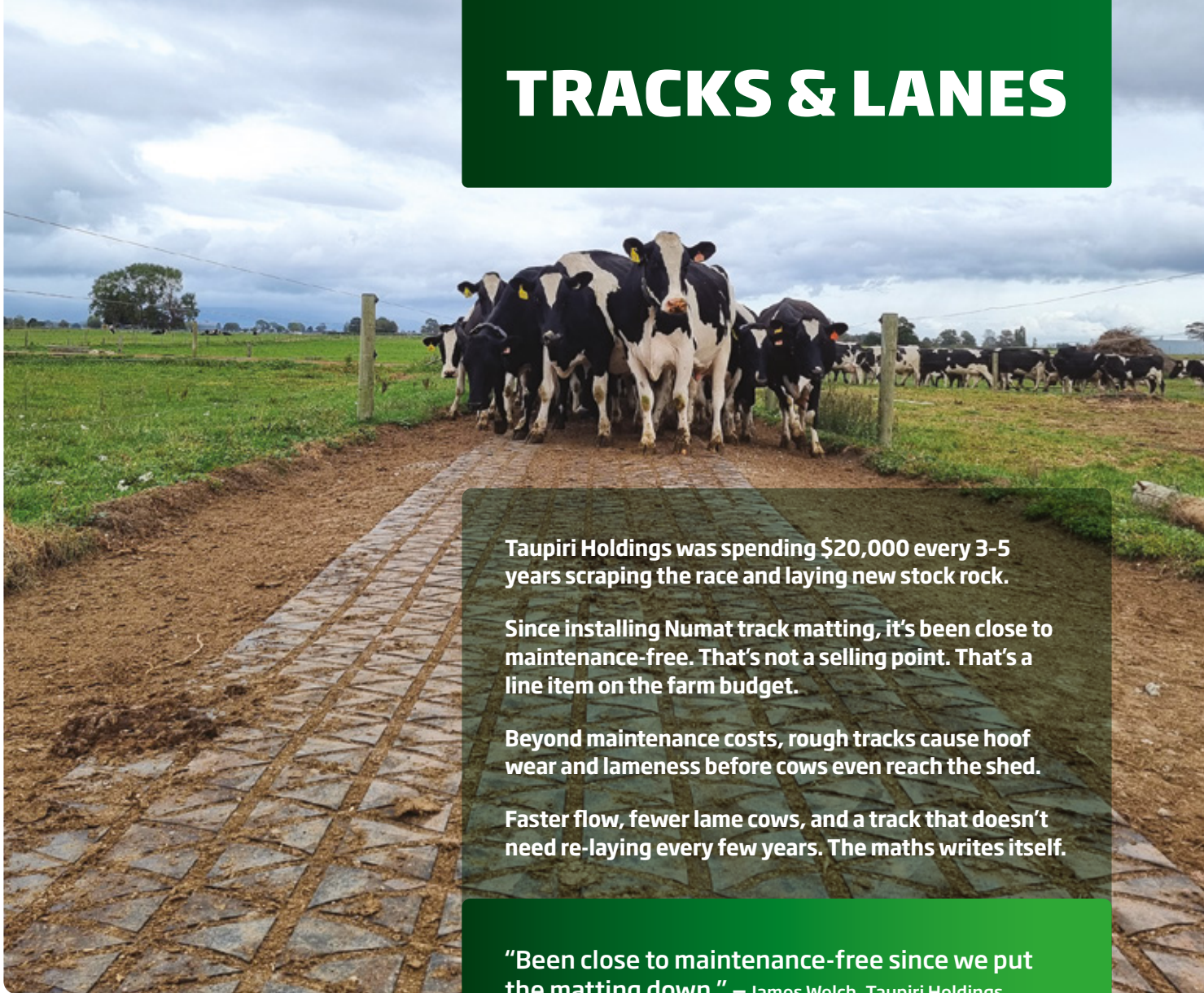

TRACKS & LANES



Taupiri Holdings was spending \$20,000 every 3-5 years scraping the race and laying new stock rock.

Since installing Numat track matting, it's been close to maintenance-free. That's not a selling point. That's a line item on the farm budget.

Beyond maintenance costs, rough tracks cause hoof wear and lameness before cows even reach the shed.

Faster flow, fewer lame cows, and a track that doesn't need re-laying every few years. The maths writes itself.

Cow Carpet

Hoof protection for the full race. 5mm thick. Keeps tracks in good nick through wet winters.

MILKING BAILS

Your cows stand in the shed twice a day, every day of the season. If the surface is hard, slippery, or uncomfortable, they fidget, they pull cups, and they produce less. It's that simple.

Paul Sheres at Grangelands Farms installed Numat matting on his 44-bail internal rotary after seeing the results at a neighbouring farm. Lameness dropped 90%. Cows step on calmer, milk quieter, and step off without hesitation.

For herringbone sheds, bail mats and pit mats protect both your cows and your operators. Eight hours a day on concrete takes its toll on legs and backs. Rubber underfoot changes that for everyone in the shed.

Interlocking Platform Mat

Cups On / Off Mats

Cows stand in one spot waiting for cups. Hard concrete means sore feet and slower milking. Rubber sorts it.

Stand cows off pasture in wet weather without destroying hooves. Soft support, easy on legs, easy to clean.

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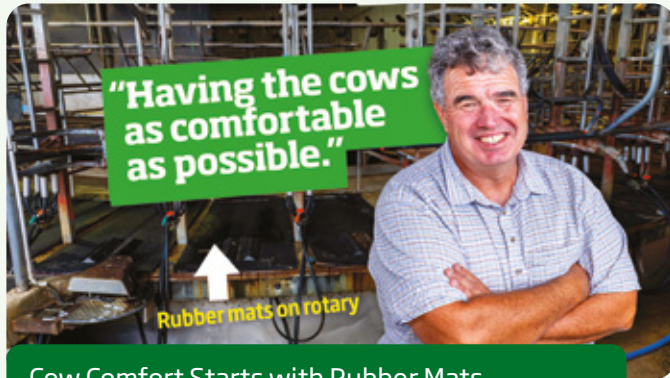
